– based on the decision of Tempus Public Foundation made in 2019 in accordance with the educational cooperation agreement in effect between Hungary and Indonesia –

HAS BEEN AWARDED A STIPENDIUM HUNGARICUM SCHOLARSHIP

for full degree studies. The scholarship has been awarded according to the details listed above.

Allowances provided for the Scholarship Holder by the Hungarian Side in case of active student status:

- Tuition-free education
 - exemption from the payment of tuition fee
- Health care services, medical insurance
 - health care services according to the relevant Hungarian legislation (Section 22 (1) i) of Act CXXII of 2019 on the Eligibility for and Funding of Social Security Benefits) and supplementary medical insurance for up to HUF 65,000 a year/person
- Monthly stipend
 - HUF / 140 000 monthly stipend for a full calendar year / the duration of the partial studies to be transferred to the scholarship holder by the higher education institution for the first phase of education (first 4 semesters)
HUF / 180,000 monthly stipend for a full calendar year to be transferred to the scholarship holder by the higher education institution for the second phase of education (second 4 semesters) until the completion of studies
- Accommodation contribution
 - dormitory place or an additional monthly contribution of HUF 40 000 to accommodation costs for a full calendar year / the duration of the partial studies
- Entitlement to Student Identification Card

The above-mentioned allowances are provided only when the Scholarship Holder has an active student status. Pursuant to the Stipendium Hungaricum Operational Regulations the scholarship holder is required to stay habitually in Hungary during the training period.

Obligations of Stipendium Hungaricum scholarship holders:

The Scholarship Holder must comply with their **reporting obligations** to Tempus Public Foundation.

Compulsory medical examination:

The Scholarship Holder is obligated to undergo the compulsory medical examination prescribed by the minister responsible for foreign affairs in the Stipendium Hungaricum scholarship programme.

If the scholarship holder is deemed unfit to continue his/her studies based on the medical examination result the scholarship holder status shall be suspended in the semester in which the medical unfitness was determined. The scholarship status is terminated if, after the repeated examination, the student is assessed to be medically unfit to continue and complete his/her studies.

The obligation regarding the compulsory medical examination applies to those students whose scholarship holder status is established in or after the 2021/2022 academic year.

Scope and validity of the scholarship:

In accordance with the point c), paragraph 5. § (2) of the 28 /2007. (V.31.) IRM regulation, the Scholarship Holder is entitled to be exempt from the payment of any fees related to his/her admission to Hungary. This document is to be presented to the immigration authorities responsible for issuing visas and residence permits.

This document is a Letter of Award, therefore it is to be issued only at the beginning of scholarship status and in case of change in data. Prior to enrolment, it is valid together with the Letter of Acceptance issued by the Hungarian host institution. Following enrolment, it is valid together with a Certificate of Student Status stating the active student status of the scholarship holder, the latter issued by the host institution. All subsequent changes in the scholarship status (e.g. change of host institution) are indicated in the Letter of Award.

According to the current Hungarian legislation, the duration of doctoral programmes is 2+2 academic years. It is not possible to extend the scholarship period on a doctoral level. At the end of the first 2 academic years, doctoral students are obliged to take a complex exam in order to assess the educational and research phase of the studies. Doctoral students can only continue with the second two-year phase if they pass this exam. The amount of the monthly scholarship is different in the two 2-year phases of the doctoral programmes.

All Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship Holders are bound by the **Operational Regulations** of the programme (that is available on the website of the programme (<https://stipendiumhungaricum.hu/>)) and the **Scholarship Agreement** and they are requested to read it carefully and participate in the programme adhering to the rules described therein. According to the regulations, the scholarship status is automatically terminated if the Scholarship Holder does not arrive and enrol until the registration date specified by the Host Institution (except in the cases described in the Operational Regulations). All Scholarship Holders are required to sign a scholarship contract with the Host Institution. The actual starting day of the scholarship period is the day when the scholarship contract is signed and comes into force. Students are required to register for an appropriate number of courses to fulfill the academic requirements of the Host Institution.
