Thirdly, the majority of young people in the country are likely to be unemployed after leaving school.

- E. I am sure that there's a big danger of more earthquakes, tsunamis etc. There is a significant risk of further earthquakes and tsunamis.
- F. Some time ago they made slavery illegal in America. Slavery was abolished in the USA in 1865.
- G. Unfortunately, the national debt in Brazil led to increased inflation, many companies going bust, and so on.

The national debt in Brazil resulted in increased inflation and bankruptcies of many companies.

- H. One day, rather soon, they will be able to cure cancer.The cure for cancer is very likely to be invented within the next decade.
- What were the main results of the Eurozone financial crisis?
 There were four main results of the Eurozone financial crisis.
